**Welcome Father José Eduardo Medeiros**

Father José Eduardo Medeiros, was born in Mosteiros, municipality of Ponta Delgada, São Miguel, Azores. At age 14, he immigrated with his family to Fall River Massachusetts, where he completed his high school studies. After high school, he joined U.S. Army, where he obtained a doctorate in Ophthalmology and Optometry. In 1980, he began his Philosophy studies in St. John's Seminary in Brighton, Mass.

Father José Eduardo joined the Order Friars Minor Conventual. He was ordained a priest on February 2, 1991 in Brooklyn, New York. After his ordination he was assigned to minister in various places in the United States, Portugal and Canada such as Spanish and Portuguese speaking parishes. He currently serves in Saint Paul, Brazil, where he is part of the Missionary Community of the Most Holy Providence.

**Welcome Bishop Edgar Moreira da Cunha**

The Most Reverend Edgar Moreira da Cunha was appointed Bishop of Fall River by Pope Francis in July of 2014 and was installed on September 24, 2014. He was born in Nova Fatima, Bahia, Brazil.

He joined the Vocationist Fathers, also known as the Society of Divine Vocations. He studied Philosophy at Universidade Catolica do Salvador, Bahia, Brazil, and Theology at Immaculate Conception Seminary, Darlington, New Jersey

Bishop da Cunha was ordained to the priesthood for the Society of Divine Vocations in 1982. Following his ordination he served as a parochial vicar of St. Michael Church, Newark, and as director of vocations for his Congregation.

From 1994 until 2000, Bishop da Cunha served as director of the house of formation of his Order in Florham Park, N.J.

He was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Newark by Pope John Paul II in 2003 and was ordained a Bishop on September 3, 2003.

**Summer Seminarian**

We welcome **Joseph Brodeur**, a seminarian of the Diocese of Providence. Joseph is a parishioner at St. Pius X, in Westerly, R.I. He will be staying with us in the parish during the summer and most of his time will be spent at the Mother of Hope Camp. He will begin his third year of Philosophy at Providence College in the Fall, while at Our Lady of Providence Seminary.

He joins seminarian **Rob Caputo**, who has been working with us as a sacristan since November. Rob also will be entering his third year of Philosophy at Providence College in the Fall.
