Faith Formation classes will resume this year 2020-21 beginning Sunday, Nov. 15

Sacramental years will meet in person:

- Grade 2: will meet every Sunday beginning November 15st 2020 from 10:30 to 11:30 with a Mass as it is part of their formation. And will be held in the Rego auditorium, from 9:30 am to 10:15 am. After the Mass grade 2 will proceed to their classroom.
- Grade 9 Confirmation class will meet every Tuesday starting November 17th 2020 from 6:00 pm to 7:00pm.
- Grades K and 1st grade will meet in person every other week.
- Grades, 3, 4,5,6,7,8, will be homeschooled.
