Please join us as we pray for peace and a deeper conversion.

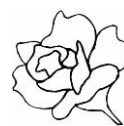
CATHOLIC CHARITY APPEAL

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

First Holy Communion dates have been selected and broken down into four groups
(October 4 & 11 at 2:00 pm).

Each student may invite up to 10 guests, all in attendance are required to follow the Covid-19 guidelines. Families may share a pew if living under the same roof otherwise must remain up to 6 feet apart in the suggested pews.

Rehearsal: Will take place 1 hour before First Holy Communion celebration begins. Students are asked to arrive at 1:00 pm for check in and our celebration will begin at 2:00 pm.

CONFIRMATION

This year's Confirmation dates were selected by their class. We have three separate Confirmation dates **(October 6, 13 & 20 at 7:00 pm)**. Students and sponsors are to arrive one hour early (6:00 pm) as we are including both Confirmation along with rehearsal. Students may invite up to 6 guests and follow the Covid 19 guidelines. If you live in the same household you may share a pew otherwise must stay six feet apart.

WELCOME BACK!

Welcome back to those who can join us for the participation of Mass here in Church. This change will not be easy and so we ask for your cooperation and patience. The Mass schedule will remain the same and we will examine how things go to see if we will make changes. Also, we will stream two Masses on the weekend.

- In early March, Bishop Tobin dispensed the faithful from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation. Bishop Tobin has extended this dispensation for the faithful of the Diocese of Providence until further notice.
- Under no circumstances may anyone who manifests symptoms of any illness attend the public celebration of Mass.
- In all instances, those entering the building must maintain the required distance of at least 6 feet at all times. This does not apply to members of families living in the same household.
- All parishioners are strongly encouraged to wear masks or other face coverings for the entirety of the celebration of Mass. Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under the age of 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or anyone who is otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.
- All parishioners must sanitize their hands upon entry to the church.
